
## NEWSLETTER ISSUE 9 July 2020

## THE LOCKDOWN ACTIVITIES

The COVID-19 pandemic has prevented our having our usual activities for the children and youth of Hout Bay. But we have found a way to help the children and ourselves get through this period. Each week we distribute 60 artpacks – 30 in Imizamo Yethu and 30 in Hangberg – to children who participated in our pre-lockdown activities. Each week the contents of the artpack are different, and each week we choose two children as prizewinners from among those who send us photos of what they have produced.

So far our weekly artpacks have contained:

- · Masks and paints and a paintbrush to decorate them
- Coloured cards on which to write a letter to someone they are missing during the lockdown
- Clay
- Egg cartons and paint to create an animal
- · Pipecleaners, sucker sticks and beads from which to create something
- Stones and paint to decorate the stones
- Playdough (and instructions on how to make more)

On Wednesday 22 July we heard the very sad news that we had lost the last Rivonia Trialist. For Denis Goldberg's family and his Trust, Andrew Mlangeni's death reminds us of the loss of Denis not so long ago. For South Africa as a whole, it means the loss – at least in living form – of the Rivonia Trialists. We knew that they could not last forever, but that does not make it any less sad. It was always heartwarming to see the mutual comradeship, friendship and respect that Comrade Andrew and Denis had for each other. Both of them remained loyal to the struggle until the end. We remember, in particular, on the occasion when the Cape Peninsula University of Technology conferred honorary degrees on him and Denis, Comrade Andrew used his graduation speech to exhort the young graduates to support the ANC. However, both he and Denis also spoke up when they saw things going wrong in the party and struggle for which they personally gave up so much.

We are pleased and grateful that we were able to have Comrade Andrew as a speaker at the online memorial that we organised for Denis. We are also very pleased that his family and foundation were able to organise an online birthday party for Andrew soon after using a similar approach.
